Steadfast in difficulties; patience; watching. Hoo. The resistance of evil appetites or passions; temperance

## Lokahi

### - seek unity and oneness

Unity, agreement, accord, unison, harmony; agreed, in unity. Mana‘o lōkahi, unanimous. ho‘olōkahi To bring about unity; to make peace and unity; to be in agreement

## Pono

### - live righteously

oodness, uprightness, morality, moral qualities, correct or proper procedure, excellence, well-being, prosperity, welfare, benefit, behalf, equity, sake, true condition or nature, duty; moral, fitting, proper, righteous, right, upright, just, virtuous, fair, beneficial, successful, in perfect order, accurate, correct, eased, relieved; should, ought, must, necessary.

## Kuleana
